



DEACON'S CORNER




"Which of the two did his father's will?" (See Saint Matthew 21:28-32) Today in the reading from Philippians we see that Jesus was obedient to the Father's will, even when it meant his death on the cross. The crux of the matter for a Christian then is to do the will of the Father, regardless of what this may mean. We need not fear as we embark on the path in which the will of God will take us. We know that God will reward us as He did for his Son and all the saints. It is not a matter of simply saying "yes" with the mouth and then turn around and not do the Father's will as the first of the sons in the parable did. It is a matter of really doing the will of the Father as the second son did. After all, our lives should be in

harmony with our prayer: "Thy will be done." Our saints, and above all, our Blessed Mother, are the best examples for us to follow. Mary's yes was a resounding yes to the will of God. In turn her yes made possible our yes. Let us then invoke her intercessions as we endeavor to do the Father's will.

AMESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR A

Homily Twenty Sixth Sunday OT A 2023

"Actions Speak Louder than Words"

I Our Actions Speak Louder than our Words.....When I was Associate Pastor at St Hugh of Lincoln Parish (2004-6), I was in a conversation with a regular summer help priest known as George The Jesuit. George, a member of the California Province would drive his BMW motorcycle from C.A to Levittown to his mom's house every summer. This conversation was about funeral homilies. I maintained that it was important in families to say the words "I love you" with meaning of course, frequently should their be an untimely death. You want your last words to someone to be meaningful. Fr George maintained that many families, like his own, weren't comfortable saying those words but the lived the meaning of the words in their actions, that they didn't have to say the words all the time. I maintained family members needed to hear the words frequently and live the words with their actions. We would never hang up the phone with out saying "I love you". Anyway we were on common ground and the message in Today"s Gospel that our actions say much more that our words.

In the final analysis our actions speak much more than our words...-that OUR FAITH IS ONLY COMPLETELY EXPRESSED IN ACTIONS

We all have good intentions. But, our intentions don't really matter. It's our actions that are grounded in and flow from our relationship with God that count.

A --<u>In the first reading</u>, Ezekiel's message from the Lord God to Israel answers the objections of those who think it is **not fair that God should give such weight to one's final decision** because a person who, after a very long virtuous life, finally chooses sin will be punished and another, who finally chooses virtue after a life of loose morals, will be rewarded.

--<u>. The second reading</u>, BEAUTIFUL HYMN TO THE Philippians, also affirms Christ's obedience to God's will by *emptying himself*, *taking human form* and humbling himself by accepting death on a cross that God the Father *exalted Christ*, *bestowed on him the name above every other name*, and made him the recipient of universal adoration.

--In the parable <u>in today's Gospel</u>, a man who has two sons tells both to go out to work in the vineyard.

FIRIST= SAYS NO>>>>>THEN DECIDES TO GO (rep. sinners, tax collectors, prostitutes.)

SECOND=SAYS YES>>>>>DOESN'T GO (religious leaders, elders)

FINAL DECISION IS MOST IMPORTANT

Context to todays Gospel passage is: Jesus is now in Jerusalem, his passion and death are immanent.

---The Saducces and Pharisees are constantly trying to trip him up and so they are questioning his authority to do ministry: to preach and teach.

--Our Lord expresses that he will answer their question only if they answer his question first (quid pro quo).

----He asks them if they thought John the Baptist's Baptism of water was of DIVINE OR EARTHLY ORIGIN. They realize they can't say DIVINE because they never put their faith in John or submitted to his baptism//and they can't say EARTHLY because the people regarded him as prophet.

--Our Lord **puts them further on the defensive** by posing to them today's parable in which their response condemns themselves.

In this parable: both sons OFFEND THEIR FATHER AND SHAME HIM. FIRST SON: response was a PUBLIC INSULT to his father by saying NO; but later he did what his father asked of him. SECOND SON: response was not a public insult but he still shamed his father by lying to him and not doing what he said he would do.<u>--this son only appeared to be faithful</u>.

C. Neither Son represents the ideal; however in deciding on the First Son the Religous Leaders condemn themselves.

--Tax Collectors and protitutes were public sinners--the were deemed the worst of the worst--yet our Lord says they will enter heaven before the religious leaders.

--WHY? It was these individuals--the lowest of the low who accepted our Lord's invitation and believed in him--repented of their sins--changed their lives--and followed him (ex. Feast of St. Matt. on Wed.)--this repentance/acceptance/following>>>these actions/doing spoke louder than any words that could ever be uttered.

D. SECOND SON offends his father by lying to him: says YES but but no actions

--- he politely says YES but never does what he says or what is asked of him.

----This son REPRESENTS especially those religious people----who may speak beautiful, pious, lofty>>>words--but these lofty words are never expressed in action>>ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO condemn others, are judgemental, and are unforgiving.

**sometimes religious people are so intent on proving they are correct that they fail to hear the voice of reason or discern the voice of God.

--EXAMPLE: someone who teaches a class on prayer but never prays himself

IV These two sons represent two approaches of how to relate to God.

1) Those who have NO WORDS: don't go to church, mass, don't pray.....YET they: FORGIVE, SHOW MERCY, GENEROUS ------they profess no faith YET their actions DISPLAY a tacit faith/presence that exists in them---we know them to be ANONYMOUS CHRISTIANS>>>>people who don't know Jesuschrist>>>due to no fault of their own yet in the way they live their lives are perhaps more Christian than many Christians.

2) those who HAVE FAITH AND ARE RELIGIOUS: YET THEY ARE: UNFORGIVING, UNMERCIFUL, HAVE NO CHARITY.

** Doing the will of God IS NOT SO MUCH ABOUT: WHAT WORDS WE SAY, THE PROMISES WE MAKE....ALL THAT IS IMPORTANT....BUT WHAT REALLY MATTERS IS THAT WE DO THE WORK THAT GOD HAS ASKED OF US.

---ST IGNATIUS: "love shows itself more in actions than in words

STORY: A young woman from Australia was traveling around India. She was walking around Calcutta one day when she came across a small boy who looked about 5 years old. He was beaten and left to die. She knew she couldn't leave him there. So, she brought him to Mother Teresa's Hospice in Calcutta. She asked if she could bring the child into the house. But she felt that she couldn't just leave him there and go away. So, she asked if she could stay and help look after him. And so she did. She nursed the child day and night and he started to improve. She began to care for others as well in Hospice.

Mother Theresa was so impressed with the woman's care for others that she ASKED HER IF SHE EVER COSIDERED RELIGIOUS LIFE.

---The woman was very moved and flattered... she knew it was very unusual for Mother Theresa to ask people directly to join her congregation.

--- The woman said, "Well, you see, I'm actually not religious at all. Both my parents were atheists. I've never been to church, I've never been baptized. I'm not sure I'm really the sort of person that becomes a nun."

---"Oh," said Mother Teresa. "Don't worry about that. When the actions are right, as are yours, the words will follow."


Conclusion: The ideal are those who say YES (eg God) and DO WHAT THEY SAY.

--God doesn't want correct answers, HE WANTS OUR ACTOINS. He wants our dutiful obedience, but more importantly he wants our enthusiastic service in building up his Father's Kingdom eg. that is getting the job done.

--IDEAL--to profess FAITH in WORD and DEED.



<u>Guidelines on bulletin articles (as per Fr. Chris Nowak, Pastor):</u>

--deadline for the upcoming Sunday is Monday at noon. E mail it to Dcn. Cris and Father Chris (this deadline must be respected).

--if your event/activity is 4 weeks away your bulletin article will be a quarter page

--if your event /activity is 3 weeks away your bulletin article will be a half page

--if your event /activity is 2 weeks away (and there is room) your bulletin article will be a full page.

-- if your event /activity is 1 week away (and there is room) your bulletin article will be a full page.

--Note: all that goes into the bulletin will be determined by the needs of the parish and will be decided by Fr. Chris.

Guidelines for Group / Ministry Witness talks:

--each group / ministry will be assigned a weekend. If you can't keep the weekend inform Braulio and you will be assigned another.

--you should have a speaker at ALL masses English and Spanish

(even English at Spanish and Spanish at English: someone can give a brief translation, but very brief. Remember this is also to advertise the existence of your group. Some parents have brought their children to translate for them or read their talk for them)

--the speaker is to follow the outline and have their talk in writing (no off the top of your head)

--the talk must be only 3-5 min. given after the closing prayer and before* the announcements. Presider will and people to sit and announce the group/ministry speaking this weed end.

--when you arrive at mass, inform the presider/priest that you will be giving the witness talk. Please adjust the microphone as needed.

--groups / ministries can have people at the doors of the Church to hand out materials (the group's responsibility).

Pautas para las charlas de Testimonio de Grupo/Ministerio:



New Volunteers:

The Diocese of Rockville Centre requires all employees, clergy, and volunteers to complete the following requirements within thirty days of volunteering:

- •Attend a Protecting God's Children class (this is a LIVE, **three-hour**, interactive workshop with facilitation that is done in person or virtually via Zoom or like platforms)


