#### Pastor's Message

#### Homily: Easter Sunday 2024: The Quest for the Risen Christ

I.- Every year in my homily I like to tell the story of an Easter Egg hunt in my brother's parish in North Carolina. One year my brother videoed my niece Cloe searching for the egg with the Risen Christ inside it. She searched for the golden egg with such zeal and enthusiasm. I hold this story up as a metaphor: that with the same zeal, joy, awe, and innocence of a child we too should be looking for the Risen Christ. We too as believers should be on the HUNT for signs of NEW LIFE in our lives and in our world. Sometimes the signs of new life are very obvious, sometimes you really have to try to see them with faith.

We celebrate the resurrection at Easter. But more importantly the Resurrection is an event that continues in our lives to the present day. What are the implications of the Resurrection? First and foremost, we believe that all our loved ones, who have died and gone before us are home in heaven, death is not the end, their existence continues on. We the living are part of the same fabric, the Communion of Saints. Heaven is hopefully our destiny; death is hopefully our birth into eternal life.

II.- Secondly, at Easter we celebrate not just the EMPTY TOMB but the RISEN CHRIST! It is the Risen Christ that transformed the Apostles and our Lord's followers. The Apostles experienced "SOMETHING" that transformed them into fierce evangelizers, something so much more than JUST AND EMPTY TOMB. THEY EXPERIENCED THE RISEN CHRIST!

--We celebrate--that very precise moment that JESUS CHRIST SPRANG FORTH FROM THE TOMB--

II STORY: A Woman, Rosemay, who worked in a nursing home. One Good Friday Afternoon they showed the Movie Jesus of Nazareth (Franco Zeffirelli production) which is a composite of several Gospels. They gathered all the very elderly together and seated them and they started the video. Rosemary was pleasantly surprised at the quiet attention being paid to the movie. The older people were really into it. Finally, the scene where Mary Magdalene comes upon the empty tomb and sees Jesus' body not there. A Young Man asks Mary why she is looking for the living among the dead. Mary runs as fast as she can back to the disciples and tells Peter and the rest in breathless excitement, He's Alive! I tell you! He's Alive! The disciples doubted her so she cried out: "You don't believe me...You don't believe me!" Many of the older people were so into the movie they cried out: "WE BELIEVE" "WE BELIEVE"

III.--THE MOMENT OUR LORD SPRAND FORTH FROM THE TOMB BEGAN THE CYCLE OF LIFE, DEATH, NEW LIFE: we see this process in all things, It is imprinted on all things in the universe. With the Easter event taking place and continuing, all of creation is surging forth in new life, the Kingdom of God is becoming manifest. Our task is like the task of that child my niece Cloe, with the same zeal, sense of wonder, and awe search for, hunt for, the RISEN CHRIST and New Life in Christ. WE TOO SHOULD SEE THE SIGNS OF NEW LIFE ALL AROUND US.


