The De La Salle School—Catholic Lasallian School for young men *Grades 5-8*

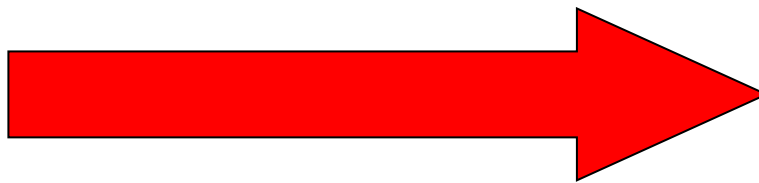

DEACON'S CORNER



“Jesus How do we know that we belong to the Truth, that is, that we belong to Christ? Do we have to take a long test, full of difficult theological questions? Do we have to belong to a special group? Do we have to engage in some special rigorous practice? Saint John in his first letter gives us the comforting answer: “Children, let us

love not in word or speech but in deed and in truth. Now this is how we shall know that we belong to the truth.” (See 1 John 3:18-24) As you can see the answer is indeed amazingly simple. No need to have a theological degree. What we need to do is to make sure that our love for our brothers and sisters is honest and expressed in deeds. To the degree that we love honesty and in deeds we belong to the Truth. Since Jesus showed us the way to love others by giving Himself for us, those who remain in Him, do likewise, following His commandment of loving as He loved. Thus, they pray for the right things and as a result their prayers are answered: “if you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask for whatever you want, and it will be done for you.” (Saint John 15:1-8)

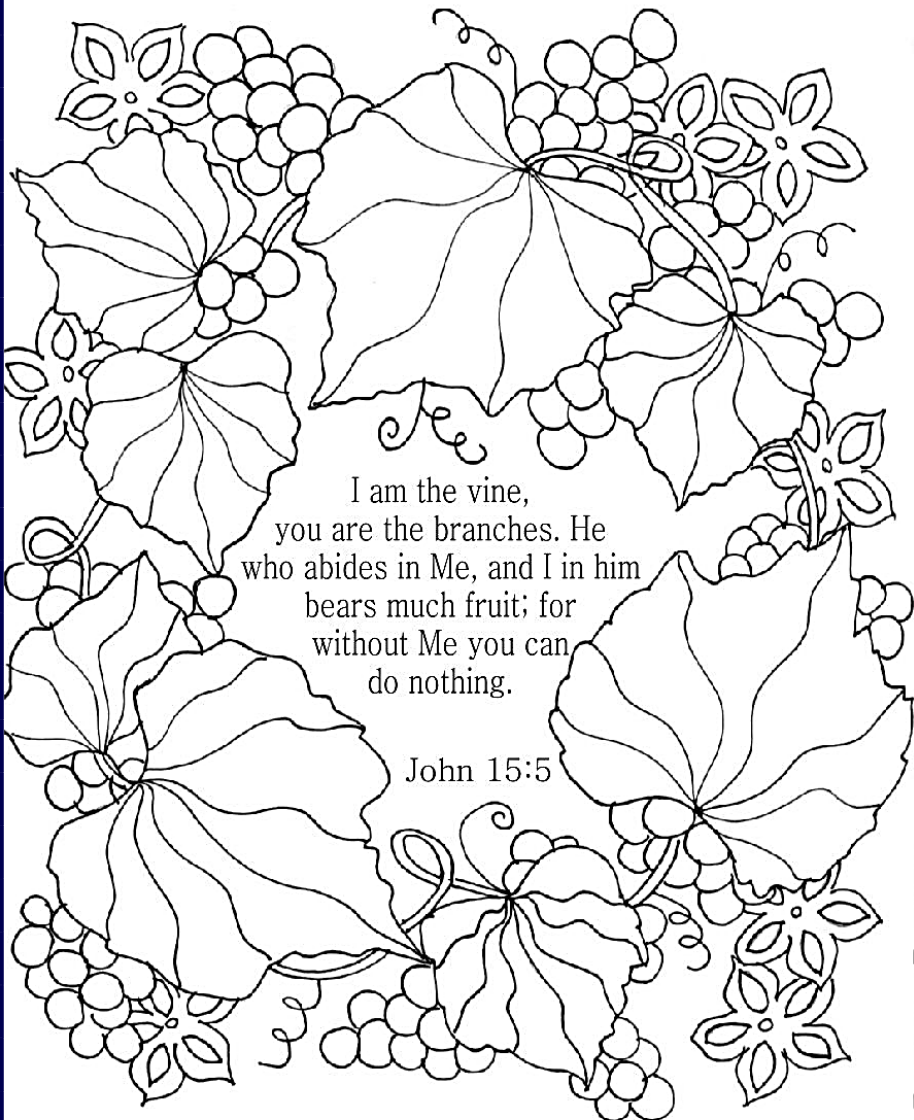

EL RINCÓN DEL DIÁCONO

“¿Cómo sabemos que somos de la verdad, es decir, que le pertenecemos a Cristo? ¿Tenemos que pasar un examen lleno de difíciles preguntas teológicas? ¿Tenemos que pertenecer a algún grupo especial? ¿Tenemos que participar en alguna práctica rigurosa? Citando del Evangelio de hoy, San Juan en su primera carta nos da la respuesta confortante: “Hijos míos: No amemos solamente de palabra; amemos de verdad y con las obras. En esto conoceremos que somos de la verdad.” (Vea la Primera Carta de San Juan 3, 18-24) Como puede ver la respuesta es ciertamente sencilla. No es necesario tener un grado teológico. ¿Cómo amamos? ¿Es nuestro amor honrado y expresado en obras, o es algo que cuelga de palabras? Al grado en que amamos honradamente y en obras pertenecemos a la verdad. Puesto que Jesús nos muestra el modo de amar a otros dándose a sí mismo por nosotros, los que permanecen en El, es decir los que siguen Su mandamiento de amarse como él nos amó también saben cómo y por qué orar: “Si permanecen en Mí y Mis palabras permanecen en ustedes, pidan lo que quieran y se les concederá.” (Vea San Juan 15, 1-8)

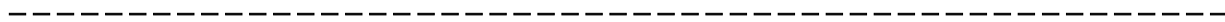

- Refinish kneeling pads and pews.



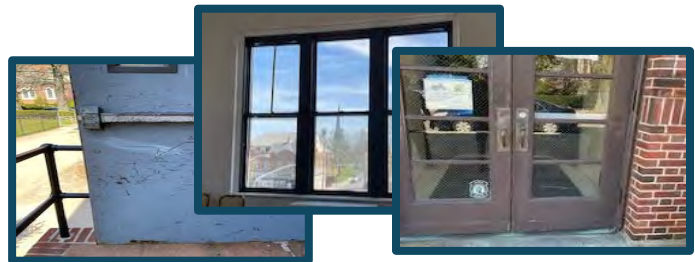
SCHOOL ROOF - \$166,100

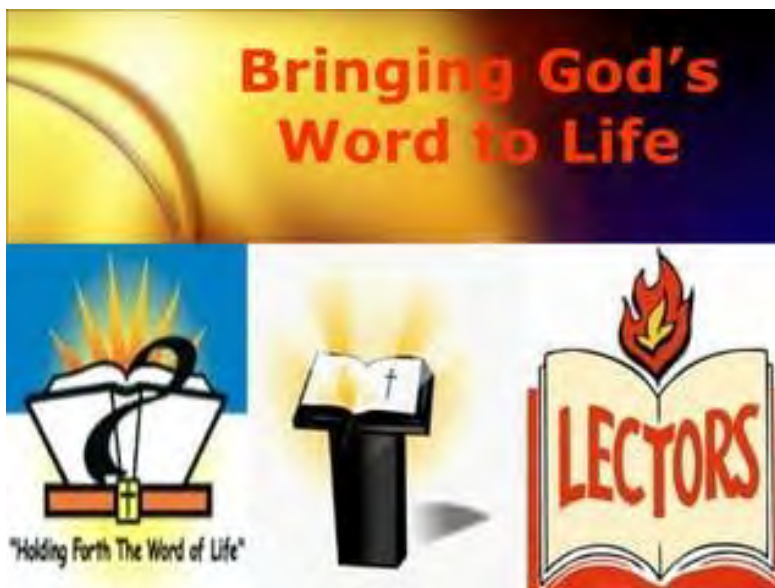

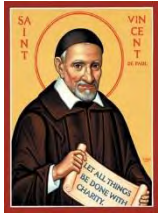

BABY'S LIFE BEFORE BIRTH

- ♥ My heart is beating at 18 to 25 days.
- ♥ The foundation for my nervous system is in place at 20 days.
- ♥ My skeleton is complete at 42 days and I have reflexes.
- ♥ My brain waves can be detected as early as 43 days.
- ♥ At 8 weeks my brain and all body systems are present and I look like a miniature doll.
