## DEACON'S CORNER



From our earliest years we have learned to know what genuine love is, not from lessons in words, but by being loved ourselves. Today's readings invite us to recognize that the Paschal Mystery that is the center of our Easter celebration is an expression of God's love for us, and an invitation to enter into the love of Jesus and his Father, and to give it expression in our own lives. True love expresses itself in action rather than in words. The Father's love, John's letter tells us, was expressed in our midst when He 'sent into the world His only Son, so that we could have life in him'. The words of Jesus in

John's gospel remind us how complete is the gift which He brings, as an expression of the love which He shares with the Father: 'No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends'. (See Saint John 15:9-17)

Genuine love is an unselfish gift. It seeks the good of the beloved rather than its own benefit. God's love is an outreach of utter generosity; it comes before any response on our part, as John's letter points out. (As the continuation of our passage puts it 'God loved us first'.) And our response can give nothing to God except the joy in the heart of the selfless giver. As we contemplate the mystery of God's generosity, we are reminded that, in the end, love is the most precious of all gifts. If it is true that true joy is the finding of what our hearts are made for, then a love that is genuine brings a joy which is without compare: 'As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you ... I have told you this that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete'. The fruit of genuine love is the intimacy of friendship – sharing all that matters in one's life with the beloved: 'You are my friends ... I call you friends because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from my Father'.'.

## EL RINCÓN DEL DIÁCONO



Desde nuestros primeros años hemos aprendido a saber qué es el amor genuino, no a través de lecciones de palabras, sino al ser amados nosotros mismos. Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a reconocer que el Misterio Pascual que es el centro de nuestra celebración pascual es una expresión del amor de Dios por nosotros y una invitación a entrar en el amor de Jesús y su Padre, y a darle expresión en nuestras propias vidas. El verdadero amor se expresa en acciones más que en palabras. El amor del Padre nos dice la carta de Juan, se expresó entre nosotros cuando "envió al mundo a su único Hijo, para que tengamos vida en Él". Las palabras de Jesús en el evangelio de Juan nos recuerdan cuán completo es el don que Él trae, como expresión del amor que comparte con el Padre: "Nadie tiene amor más grande a sus amigos que el que da la vida por ellos". (San Juan 15, 9-17)

El amor genuino es un regalo desinteresado. Busca el bien del amado más que su propio beneficio. El amor de Dios es una extensión de total generosidad; viene antes de cualquier respuesta de nuestra parte, como señala la carta de Juan. (Como dice la continuación de nuestro pasaje: "Dios nos amó primero".) Y nuestra respuesta no puede darle nada a Dios excepto el gozo en el corazón del dador desinteresado. Al contemplar el misterio de la generosidad de Dios, recordamos que, al final, el amor es el más precioso de todos los regalos. Si es cierto que el verdadero gozo es encontrar aquello para lo que está hecho nuestro corazón, entonces un amor genuino trae un gozo sin comparación: 'Como el Padre me ha amado, así os he amado... os lo he dicho. esto para que mi alegría esté en ustedes y su alegría sea completa'. El fruto del amor genuino es la intimidad de la amistad: compartir todo lo que importa en la vida con el amado: "Ustedes son mis amigos... Los llamo amigos porque les he hecho saber todo lo que he aprendido de mi Padre".

## Pastor's Message

MAY 5, 2024

*"A faithful friend is a sturdy shelter; he who finds one finds a treasure." - Sirach 6:14*

I ---Last week: The Vine and Branches metaphor: Lord implores us to stay connected to Him always: the Eucharist is our life blood.

---Now our Lord uses a more profound metaphor: FRIENDSHIP: not only to inspire our closeness to Him but also that we show initiative in our Friendship with him.

STORY: It was a busy morning, about 8:30, when an elderly gentleman in his 80's arrived to have stitches removed from his thumb. He said he was in a hurry as he had an appointment at 9:00 am. The NURSE took his vital signs and had him take a seat, knowing it would be over an hour before someone would be able to see him. Since he, himself, was not busy the NURSE took time to evaluate the man's wound. The wound was well healed, and so he talked to one of the doctors, got the needed supplies to remove his sutures and redress his wound.

---While taking care of his wound, the NURSE asked his patient if he had another doctor's appointment as he was in such a hurry. The gentleman said that he needed to go to the nursing home to eat breakfast with his wife.

--The NURSE asked about his wife's health, the old man responded that she had been there for a while and that she was a victim of Alzheimer's disease. Then the nurse asked if his wife would be upset if he was a bit late, he replied that she no longer knew who he was, that she had not recognized him in five years now. The NURSE was surprised, and asked him why, if his wife didn't know who he was, WHY HE WENT EVERY MORNING for breakfast.

----The old man smiled and said, "She MAY NOT KNOW ME ANYMORE, but I still know who she is." The Nurse with tears in the eyes said, "WHAT A BEAUTIFUL TRUE LOVE"

**\*\*True love is Agape Love: it is an acceptance of all that is, has been, and will be. THIS IS THE KIND OF LOVE THAT JESUS WANTS US TO SHOW TO OTHERS: SACRIFICIAL AND SELFLESS. ---IT IS neither physical, nor romantic.---Agape love is: selfless, sacrificial, unconditional love: it is the highest form of love. It is NOT emotion or feeling or sentiment. It is demonstrated through actions: It is Divine love.**

In the Gospel we hear the very profound words: "LOVE ONE ANOTHER AS I HAVE LOVED YOU" NOTICE: EXPRESSED IN THE PAST TENSE: "AS I HAVE LOVED YOU" ---BECAUSE GOD HAS LOVED US FIRST--

**\*\* There is a very important human (psychological and spiritual) PRINCIPAL BEING expressed here: A HUMAN BEING WHO HAS NEVER FELT LOVE IN HIS/HER LIFE (parents, siblings, spouse, children) CAN NOT SHOW LOVE.**



---UNLESS a human being experiences love, feels loved in this life: they can never love another person:  
NOR SHOW LOVE.

---It is an impossibility for someone who HAS NEVER FELT LOVED IN THIS LIFE TO LOVE  
ANOTHER PERSON—

---OUR LORD SAYS THESE WORDS TO EMPOWER PEOPLE WHO MAY HAVE NEVER FELT LOVED  
BY ANYBODY (or maybe not in their life right now) THEY KNOW GOD'S LOVE AND TO BE ABLE TO  
REFLECT HIS INFINITE LOVE TO OTHERS.

II \*\*\*---It is said that if you have one or two best friends during your lifetime you are a blessed  
person.

----In the Gospel this weekend we move from previous METAPHORS (Good Shepherd, Vine, and  
Branches) to the METAPHOR OF FRIENDSHIP: "You are my friends if you do what I command, Love  
one another as I have loved you."

----The scene is the Last Supper, the evening before our Lord's crucifixion and He is trying to prepare  
his disciples for his impending death the following day. He knows their faith will be shaken when they  
see him hang upon the cross, so he is preparing them for how to live once He is gone and He comforts  
them by expressing that He will always be close to them.

----Our Lord does this by using several metaphors that the disciples and the people of the time could  
relate to. In the readings for the previous two Sundays our Lord uses the metaphors of the Good  
Shepherd and the Vine and the Branches.

----TODAY: our Lord uses a radical new metaphor to capture a new and profound way of discipleship:  
FRIENDSHIP.

First, what is friendship? Friends are equals . . . mutuality.

--neither subservient nor submissive nor the other dominant. --Friends spend time together and  
enjoy each other's company.

---Friends usually have a common history together (e.g. grew up together).

--someone you can rely on and turn to in difficult times and times of joy.

---Friends are committed to their friendship and take the initiative to nurture it through  
communication and getting together and CATCHING UP.

--someone you can trust they are always going to be there. ----generally, have common interests and  
goals.

---Friends are loyal to one another.

--- A Friend will make sacrifices when needed.

III. When we apply these attributes to our relationship with our Lord, CAN WE SAY WE have been  
good friends to our Lord?

----Our Lord says, "You are my friends if you do what I command . . . Love one another as I have loved you." THE SAME LOVE OUR LORD SHOWS US WE NEED TO SHOW TO ONE ANOTHER.

--Do you need to forgive someone in your life / or ask forgiveness?

--Do you need to be more merciful: show compassion, have more patience with others?

--Do you need to show more charity to others?

\*\*\*HAVE WE LOVED OTHERS AS OUR LORD LOVES US?\*\*\*

---CRITERIA FOR DISCIPLESHIP / THE CRITERIA FOR FRIENDSHIP: IS LOVE

---how many people can say they pray to our Lord or attend mass every Sunday and receive the sacraments?

---Catholics today know that our Lord prepared this altar with his sweat and blood and his very life and Death—yet they stay away and barely come to mass but once a month, if that.

---How many believers work towards justice and helping the poor. ---How many are as forgiving as our Lord and as unconditionally loving and accepting as our Lord?
