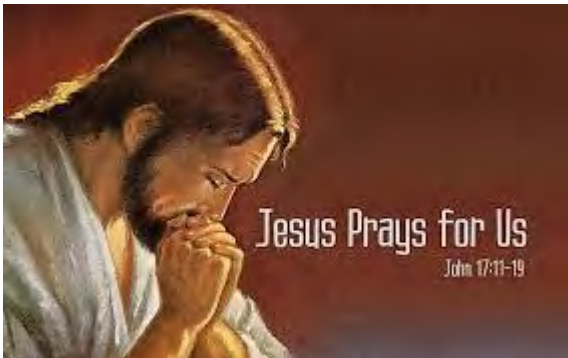

DEACON'S CORNER



Today's Gospel quotes Jesus' prayer to His Heavenly Father in that last supper with His disciples. I have always been impressed by what he asks: "that they may be one just as we are one." (See Saint John 17:11b-19). Did the Father answer Jesus' prayer? Saint Paul believed that the Father had answered the prayer. We know this because on every one of his letters he addresses the disciples as those who are "in Christ". The question is do we believe that the Father answered Jesus' prayer?

Do we believe that we are one with Christ as the Father and Christ are one? Obviously, many don't. If they did, our world would be a different place. The reason may be that they do not know about this prayer. Others may know about it, but they can scarcely believe it. However, those who do, show by their lives the power of believing in their union with Christ. Take for instance the lives of Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta and Saint John Paul II. What about you? Do you believe that you are one with Christ as Christ is one with the Father?

El Evangelio de hoy cita la oración de Jesús a Su Padre Celestial en la última cena con Sus discípulos. (Ver San Juan 17: 11b-19). ¿Respondió el Padre la oración de Jesús? San Pablo creía que el Padre había respondido a la oración. Lo sabemos porque en todas sus cartas se dirige a los discípulos como aquellos que están "en Cristo". La pregunta es: ¿Lo creemos nosotros? ¿Creemos que somos uno con Cristo como el Padre y Cristo lo son? Obviamente, muchos no lo creen. Si lo hicieran, nuestro mundo sería un lugar diferente. La razón puede ser que desconozcan esta petición de Jesús. Otros quizás la conocen, pero apenas pueden creer que eso sea posible. Los que sí lo creen, muestran en sus vidas el poder de creer en su unión con Cristo. Tomemos, por ejemplo, las vidas de Santa Madre Teresa de Calcuta y San Juan Pablo II. ¿Y usted? ¿Cree que está "en Cristo", que es uno con Cristo como Cristo es uno con el Padre?

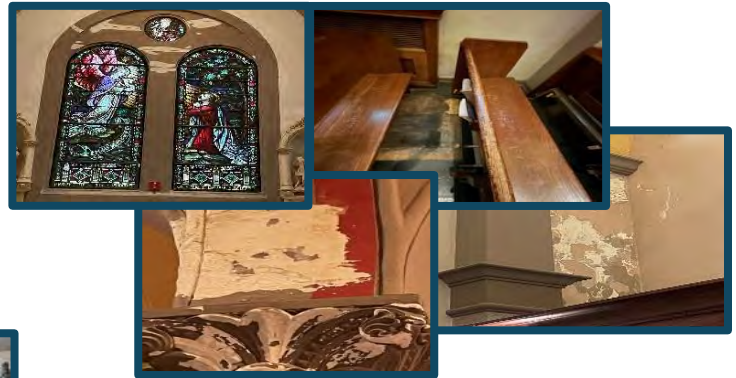
PRELIMINARY CASE STATEMENT

Our beloved church has adapted and expanded to the needs of parishioners in order to remain a thriving oasis of faith and community.

Today we find ourselves in an exciting moment in our parish's history. As we look forward to the future, we recognize the need to renovate our church and school. The proposed necessary projects for the church and school have been carefully identified.

CHURCH INTERIOR - \$623,731

- Repair interior walls and floors that were damaged before the roof replacement, by rainfall and faulty HVAC system.
- Refinish kneeling pads and pews.



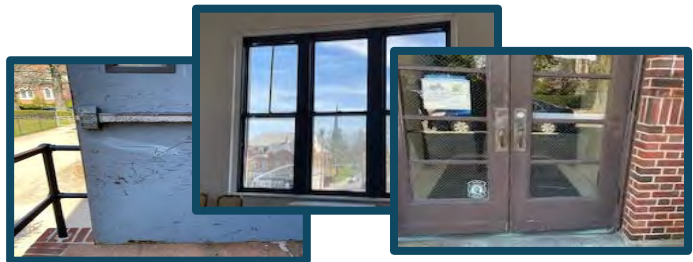
SCHOOL ROOF - \$166,100

- Replace the roof to prevent damage to the 100 years old front and main body of the school building.

SCHOOL

WINDOWS AND DOORS - \$453,525

- Replace and upgrade the 40-year-old, worn out and rusted, original doors and windows.



SCHOOL AIR CONDITIONING (BASEMENT) - \$68,000

- Replace the current air conditioning unit that has reached its life expectancy at over 25 years old, to ensure proper cooling of the meeting rooms in the school basement.

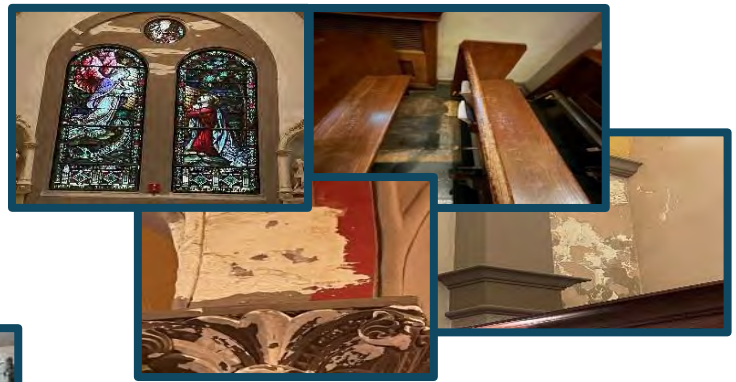
DECLARACIÓN PRELIMINAR DEL CASO

- Restaurar las almohadillas para arrodillarse y los bancos.

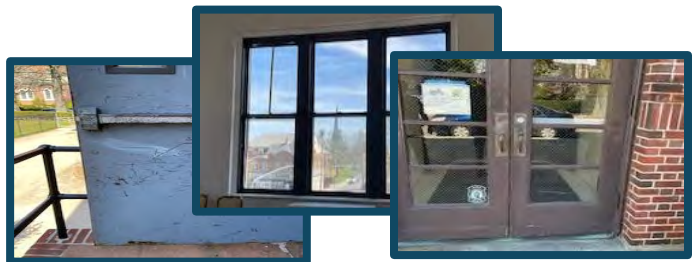


AZOTEA DE LA ESCUELA- \$166,100

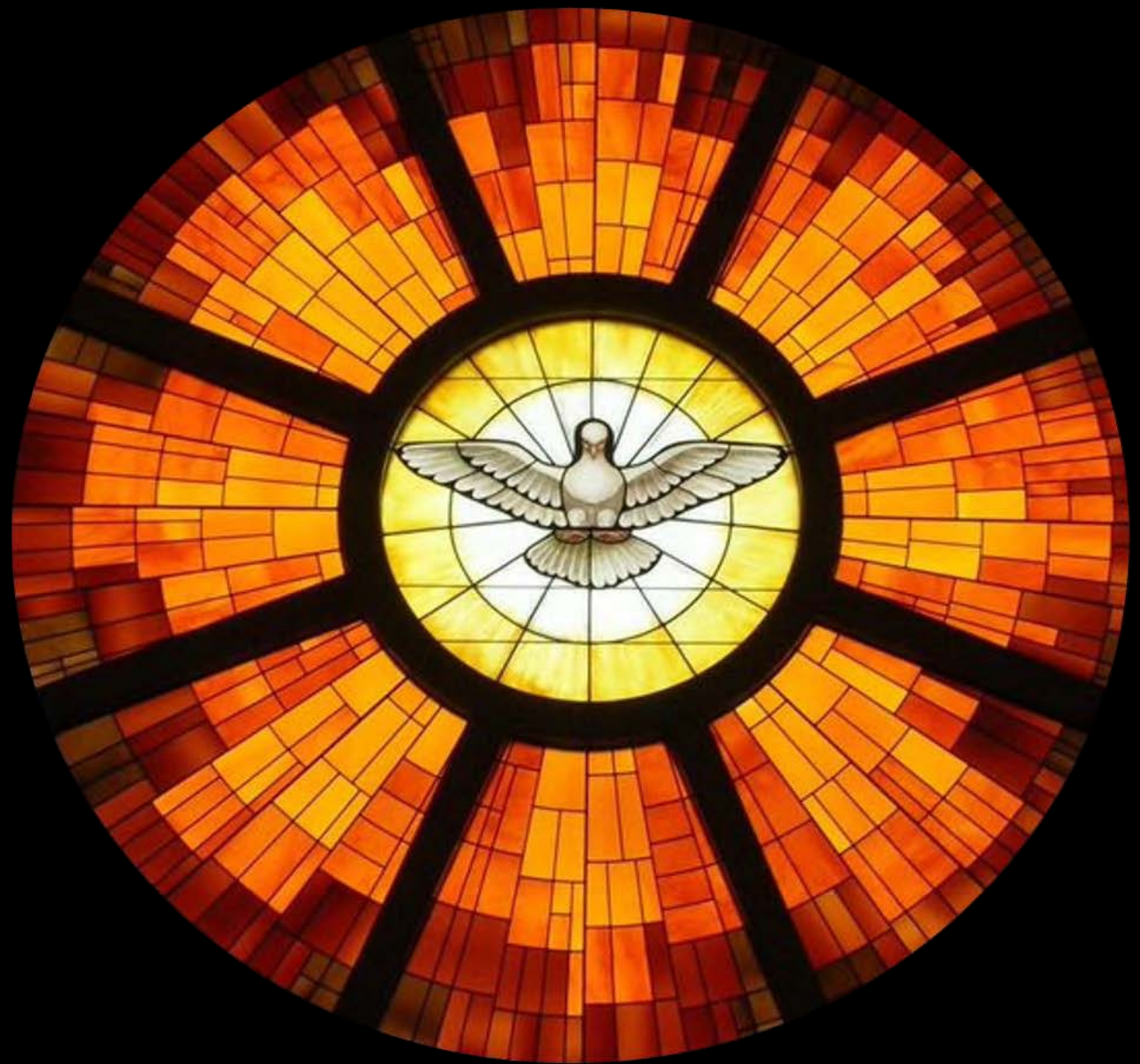

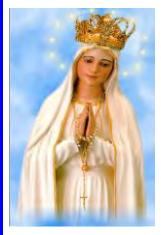
