Pastor's Message

MAY 19, 2024

I Jesus knew that he had to keep his Apostles together, so he gives them the Eucharist. At the end of which he says, "Do this in memory of me." Repeat my words and actions and I will be truly (really) present to you. So, the Apostles are together for the out pouring of the Holy Spirit, the beginning of the church. Jesus, now the Christ knows that his Apostles will work to fulfill the mission: to build the Kingdom of God.

I'd like to use several stories; I use stories because narrative speaks to the heart and soul (the 4 Gospels are narratives). These three stories serve as a metaphor that captures the treasure and richness of our lives, we just have to be AWARE. Many people don't even recognize the treasure and giftedness in their lives.

STORY: Once, a mother took her five-year-old son with her to a concert by **Ignace Paderewski, the great Polish pianist**. She did this to motivate her son with his piano lessons. The mother and her son got their seats close to the stage. Then the mother met her old friend and got involved talking with her. She failed to notice that her son had slipped away to do some exploring.

--At the right time the lights dimmed, and the spotlight came on. The mother looked around for her son. Only then did the mother see her five-year-old son on the stage, sitting on the piano bench, innocently picking out "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little star." The great Paderewski walked onto the stage. Walking over to the piano, he whispered to the boy, "KEEP PLAYING." Then, leaning over the boy, Paderewski reached out his left hand and began to fill in the bass. Later, he reached around the other side of the boy and added a running obbligato. Together, the great maestro and the tiny five-year-old mesmerized the audience with their playing.

POINT: The image of the great maestro and the tiny five-year-old at the piano makes a fitting image of the Holy Spirit coming upon the disciples. On the first Pentecost the Holy Spirit whispered encouragement to the disciples. The Holy Spirit transformed the feeble efforts of the disciples into something powerful AND BEAUTIFUL. **The same with us:** as we play a simple tune of life...the Holy Spirit is leaning over us turning our simple song into a great symphony**

STORY: During the Great Depression, a man by the name of Yates owned a sheep ranch in West Texas. Day by day he grazed his sheep and wondered how he was going to pay his bills. It was in the middle of the Depression, and even government subsidies would not give him enough income to break even. Then one day an oil company came to town. They asked permission to drill a wildcat well on Mr. Yates' land. At 1,115 feet, they struck oil to the tune of 80,000 barrels a day.

POINT: Mr. Yates and his family were struggling economically yet they were living right above great wealth and didn't even know it. **SUCH IT IS WITH OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE:** People live in a spiritual poverty not even realizing the great treasure in their souls in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. People just have to open their hearts to the Holy Spirit in Prayer and ask to be able to discern the Gifts of the Spirit.

STORY: An old beggar lay on his deathbed. His last words were to his young son who had been his constant companion during his begging trips. "Dear son," he said, "I have nothing to give you except a cotton bag and a dirty bronze bowl which I got in my younger days from the junk yard of a rich lady." After his father's death, the boy continued begging, using the bowl his father had given him. One day a gold merchant dropped a coin in the boy's bowl, and he was surprised to hear a familiar clinking sound. "Let me check your bowl," the merchant said. To his great surprise, he found that the beggar's bowl was made of pure gold. "My dear young man," he said, "why do you waste your time begging? You are a rich man. That bowl of yours is worth at least thirty thousand dollars."

POINT: People often like this beggar have failed to recognize and appreciate the value of **WHAT IS RIGHT IN THEIR HANDS**. We fail to appreciate the infinite value of the Holy Spirit living within each of us, imbuing the gifts and fruits and charisms of the Holy Spirit.

On this Pentecost let us be mindful of the great treasure we have been given in the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

II Let us quickly review our great treasure: the Gifts of the Holy Spirit:

Wisdom—the first and highest of the gifts because it is the perfection of faith. Through **WISDOM** we come to value properly what we believe in faith.

Understanding—While wisdom is the desire to contemplate the things of God, understanding allows us grasp, at least in a limited way, the very essence of the truths of the Catholic Faith. Through understanding, we gain a certitude about our beliefs that moves beyond.

Counsel—prudence is a virtue: counsel is spiritual guidance telling us what to do.

Fortitude: IS THE strength to act on what **COUNSEL TELLS US TO DO**.

Knowledge—is often confused with both wisdom and understanding. Like wisdom, knowledge is the perfection of faith, but whereas *wisdom gives us the desire to judge* all things according to Our Faith, *knowledge is the actual ability to do so*. Like counsel, it is aimed at our actions in this life. In a limited way, knowledge allows us to see the circumstances of our life the way that God sees them. Through this gift of the Holy Spirit, we can determine God's purpose for our lives and live accordingly.

Piety—Piety takes the practice of **FAITH** from a sense of duty (I have to do this . . .) to: I do this out of Love...

Fear of the Lord—You love God so much you don't want to offend him. You practice the faith not out of fear but out of love for the Lord.

CONCLUSION: When we were confirmed and received the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, our great treasure, we were called to carry out Christ's mission, to build the Kingdom of God. Jesus calls us friends; He calls us coheirs. We need to use our great treasure to fulfill the Father's mission.

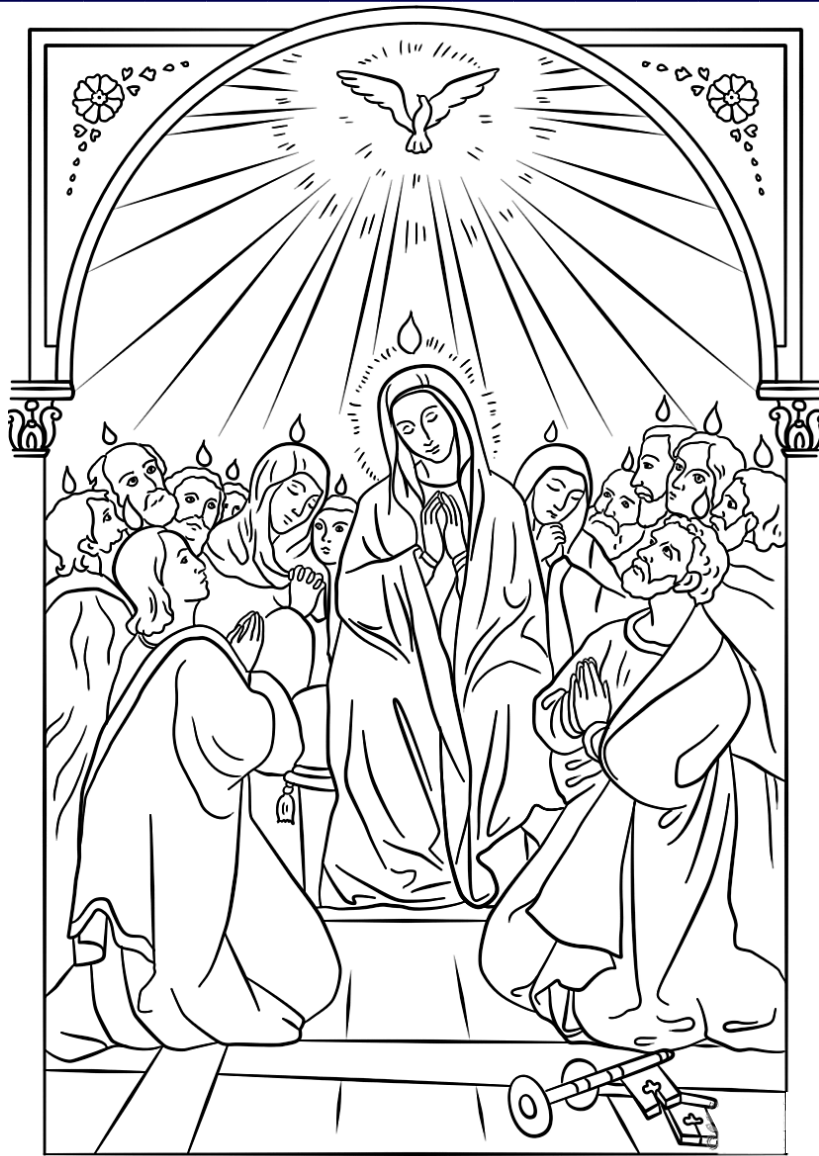
