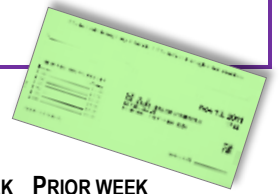

DEACON'S CORNER



Today as we celebrate Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week, we read the entire Passion according to Luke, Chapters 22 & 23. We reach the climax of the passion as we hear Jesus say to the supplicant thief, "today you will be with Me in paradise." Think about it. This man was an evildoer, but from Jesus' behavior on the cross he expressed his faith. He asked to be remembered by Jesus at his entrance into the kingdom.

This man did not hear him preach. This man simply saw him crucified. But even as he died, Jesus had gained a new convert. This man concluded that Jesus truly was the Son of God. What do we feel when we kneel at the point of Jesus' death during the Passion reading? Do we believe in our hearts that He is truly the Son of God? Does His death on the cross impel us to also die with Him on the cross so that also with Him we may be resurrected and enjoy paradise? As Saint Paul says: "I have been put to death with Christ on His Cross, so that it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me." (Galatians 2:19,20) After the cross we have the resurrection. After the cross we have His promise "today you will be with Me in paradise."

Hoy, al celebrar el Domingo de Ramos y el inicio de la Semana Santa, leemos la Pasión completa según San Lucas, capítulos 22 y 23. Llegamos al clímax de la pasión cuando escuchamos a Jesús decirle al ladrón suplicante: «Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso». Piénsenlo. Este hombre era un malhechor, pero debido al comportamiento de Jesús en la cruz, pudo expresar su fe en Jesús. Pidió ser recordado por Jesús al entrar en el reino. Este hombre no lo escuchó predicar. Simplemente lo vio crucificado. Pero incluso al morir, Jesús había ganado un nuevo converso. Este hombre concluyó que Jesús era verdaderamente el Hijo de Dios. ¿Qué sentimos cuando nos arrodillamos ante la muerte de Jesús durante la lectura de la Pasión? ¿Creemos de corazón que Él es verdaderamente el Hijo de Dios? ¿Su muerte en la cruz nos impulsa a morir también con Él en la cruz para que también con Él podamos resucitar y disfrutar del paraíso? Como dice San Pablo: «Estoy crucificado con Cristo y ya no vivo yo, Cristo vive en mí» (Gálatas 2:19-20). Después de la cruz, tenemos la resurrección. Después de la cruz, tenemos su promesa: «Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso».

Pastor's Message for Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

1.-- Today we celebrate Palm Sunday. Today we begin the journey with our Lord commemorating his passion, death, and resurrection.

--We relive the events which brought about our redemption and salvation. The Holy Week liturgy makes present for us the actual events of the dying and rising of Jesus.

--Further, the liturgy enables us to experience in our lives here and now what Jesus went through then.

--What we commemorate and relive during this week is not just Jesus' dying and rising, but our own dying and rising in Him.

--Just as Jesus did, we too must lay down our lives freely by actively participating in the Holy Week liturgy.

--Proper participation in the Holy Week liturgy will deepen our relationship with God, increase our faith and strengthen our lives as disciples of Jesus.

--But let us remember that Holy Week can become "holy" for us only if we actively and consciously take part in the liturgy of this week.

--During this week of passion, passionate suffering, passionate grace, passionate love and passionate forgiving, each of us is called to remember the Christ of Calvary and then to embrace and lighten the burden of the Christ.

--Christ's passion continues to be experienced in the hungry, the poor, the sick, the homeless, the lonely and the outcast.

2. Today's liturgy combines two contrasting moments: of glory and suffering - the welcome of Jesus in Jerusalem and the drama of his trial culminating in his crucifixion.

A The Gospel at the entrance of the church today: describes the reception, which Jesus received from his followers, who paraded with him for a distance of two miles: from the Mount of Olives to the city of Jerusalem.

--Two-and-a-half thousand people were normally present to celebrate the Jewish feast of the Passover.

B. In the second part of today's gospel, we listen to the Passion of Christ according to Luke.

--We are challenged to examine our own lives in the light of some of the people in the story like

--Peter who denied Jesus, Judas who betrayed Jesus, Pilate who acted against his conscience and condemned Jesus to death on the cross, Herod who ridiculed Jesus and the leaders of the people who preserved their position by getting rid of Jesus.

CONCLUSION: QUESTION FOR US ON THIS PALM SUNDAY IS: Am I ready to surrender my life to Jesus during this Holy Week and welcome him into all areas of my life as my Lord and Savior, singing "hosanna"?

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter to you and your families in this Jubilee Year of Hope!

Our celebration of Easter rekindles our hope each year.

The Tomb is empty! Jesus is Risen!

A wealthy man and a member of the Sanhedrin, St. Joseph of Arimathea is one of those Gospel characters with a very brief but very important role.

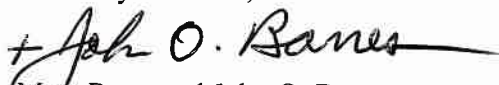
In John 19:38-42, we see that after Jesus' Crucifixion, Joseph of Arimathea asks Pilate for permission to take away Our Lord's Body. This was a bold and courageous act of faith from a man "seeking the Kingdom of God." (Mark 15:43)

Joseph and Nicodemus together place our Lord's Body reverently in linen cloths prepared with myrrh, aloes and spices: "Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden a new tomb where no one had ever been laid. So because of the Jewish day of Preparation, as the tomb was close at hand, they laid Jesus there."

In his commentary on the Gospel of Matthew, Fr. Simeon Leiva-Merikakis gives tribute to Joseph of Arimathea. He writes: "And how can we fail to do homage to Joseph of Arimathea? In performing a very humane corporal work of mercy by seeking out and burying the corpse of his beloved Teacher, Joseph becomes for all time a living icon of the eternal Father himself, stooping with compassion to enfold within his throbbing breast the mangled body of his beloved, Son, whom he himself handed over to sinners out of love for mankind. At long last, the Son of God on earth has fallen into the hands, not of a sinner, but of a just and compassionate man! Joseph of Arimathea enacts the justice and love of God himself."¹

As we celebrate Easter Sunday, the Easter Octave, Divine Mercy Sunday and the Easter Season, let us remember and ask the intercession of the great Joseph of Arimathea who prepared the Tomb of Christ and the Body of Christ with such sensitive care and compassion, such faith, courage and reverence. The Tomb is Empty! He is Risen!

Un hombre adinerado y miembro del Sanedrín, San José de Arimatea es uno de esos personajes del Evangelio con un papel muy breve pero muy importante.

En Juan 19:38-42, vemos que después de la Crucifixión de Jesús, José de Arimatea pide permiso a Pilato para llevarse el Cuerpo de Nuestro Señor. Este fue un acto audaz y valiente de fe de parte de un hombre que “esperaba el Reino de Dios.” (Marcos 15:43)

José y Nicodemo juntos colocan el Cuerpo de nuestro Señor con reverencia en lienzos de lino preparados con mirra, áloe y especias: “En el lugar donde fue crucificado había un huerto, y en el huerto un sepulcro nuevo en el que aún no habían puesto a nadie. Como era el día de la Preparación de los judíos, y el sepulcro estaba cerca, pusieron allí a Jesús.”

En su comentario al Evangelio de Mateo, el P. Simeon Leiva-Merikakis rinde homenaje a José de Arimatea. Escribe: “¿Y cómo no rendir homenaje a José de Arimatea? Al realizar una obra de misericordia corporal muy humana, al buscar y enterrar el cadáver de su amado Maestro, José se convierte para siempre en un icono viviente del Padre eterno, inclinándose con compasión para acoger en su pecho palpitante el cuerpo destrozado de su amado Hijo, a quien él mismo entregó a los pecadores por amor a la humanidad. ¡Por fin, el Hijo de Dios en la tierra ha caído en manos, no de un pecador, sino de un hombre justo y compasivo! José de Arimatea representa la justicia y el amor del mismo Dios.”¹

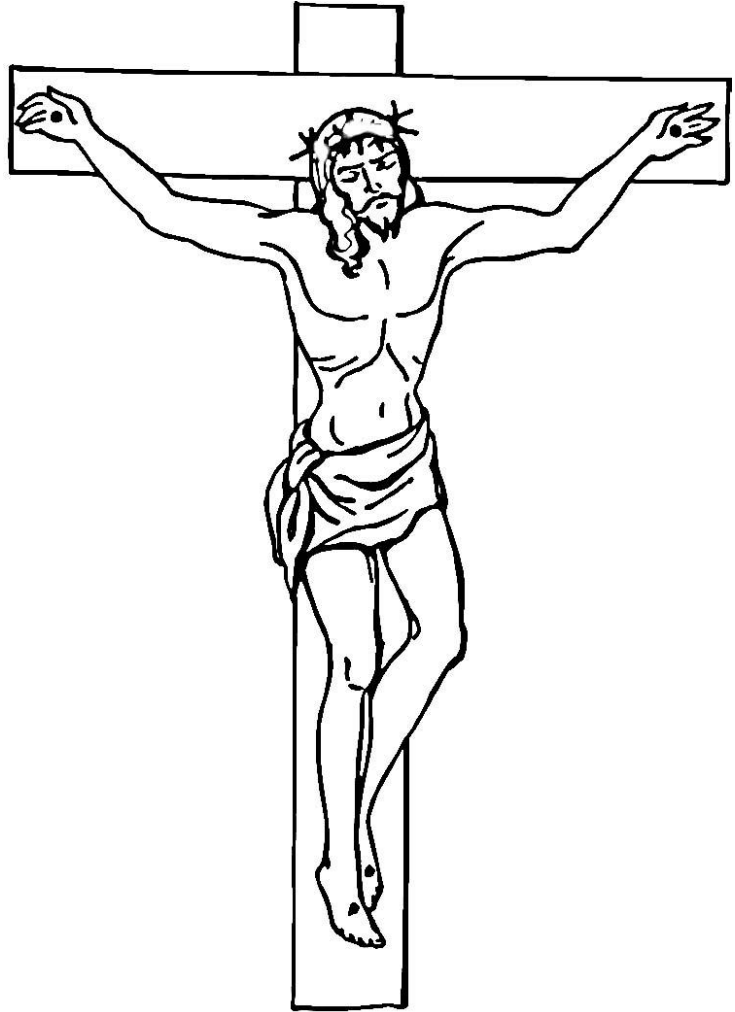
