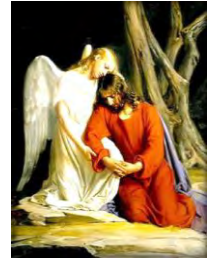

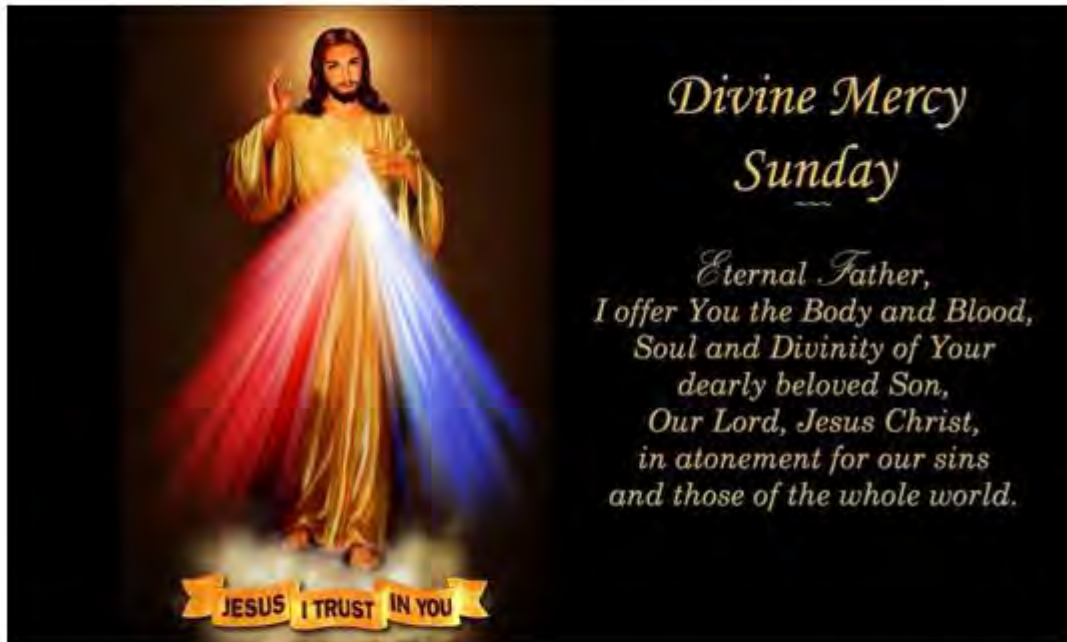

DEACON'S CORNER



The Holy Spirit binds us together as a community of faith and strengthens us to bear witness to Jesus' Resurrection.

Jesus' words to his disciples also highlight the integral connection between the forgiveness of sins and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Forgiveness and reconciliation are gifts to us from Jesus. With the grace of the Holy Spirit, we can share these with others. This is another essential aspect of what it means to be Christ's Church. The Church continues Jesus ministry of forgiveness and reconciliation.

Thomas, the disciple who doubts, represents the reality of the Church that comes after this first community of disciples. All but the first disciples of Jesus must believe without seeing. Like Thomas, we may doubt the news that Jesus, who was crucified and buried, appeared to his disciples. It is part of our human nature to seek hard evidence that the Jesus who appeared to the disciples after his death is, indeed, the same Jesus who was crucified. Thomas is given the opportunity to be our representative who obtains this evidence. He gives witness to us that the Jesus who was raised is the same Jesus who had died. Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are among those who are blessed for we have not seen and yet have believed.

Es parte de nuestra naturaleza humana buscar evidencia contundente de que el Jesús que se apareció a los discípulos después de su muerte es, en realidad, el mismo Jesús que fue crucificado. Tomás tiene la oportunidad de ser nuestro representante y obtener esta evidencia. Él nos da testimonio de que el Jesús que resucitó es el mismo Jesús que murió. Por el don del Espíritu Santo estamos entre los bienaventurados porque no hemos visto y sin embargo hemos creído.

Bishop Barres' Statement on the Death of Pope Francis

April 21, 2025

As we mourn the death of Pope Francis on this Easter Octave Monday and the gift of his contemplative global evangelization grounded in Matthew 25 and the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, we give thanks to Father, Son and Holy Spirit for his unique graces and charisms and the compelling way during his Pontificate that he has been a Light of Jesus Christ and the mission of mercy of the Catholic Church to the world.

In *Evangelii Gaudium* (2013), Pope Francis speaks about the original freshness of the Gospel: “Jesus can also break through the dull categories with which we would enclose him and he constantly amazes us by his divine creativity. Whenever we make the effort to return to the source and to recover the original freshness of the Gospel, new avenues arise, new paths of creativity open up, with different forms of expression, more eloquent signs and words with new meaning for today’s world. Every form of authentic evangelization is always ‘new.’” (11)

Pope Francis’ commitment to the freshness of the Gospel and his desire to forge new paths of mission creativity were expressed in his encyclicals *Lumen Fidei* (2013), *Laudato si’* (2015), *Fratelli Tutti* (2020), and *Dilexit Nos* (2024), along with his apostolic exhortations *Evangelii Gaudium* (2013), *Amoris Laetitia* (2016) and *Gaudete et Exsultate* (2018), *Christus Vivit* (2019), *Querida Amazonia* (2020), *Laudate Deum* (2023), and *C’est la confiance* (2023).

This section of *Evangelii Gaudium* captures, I believe, Pope Francis’ passionate love for the Church and the world and it will continue to inspire us as the Holy Spirit leads us further into the 21st century: “How I long to find the right words to stir up enthusiasm for a new chapter of evangelization full of fervor, joy, generosity, courage, boundless love and attraction! Yet I realize that no words of encouragement will be enough unless the fire of the Holy Spirit burns in our hearts. A spirit-filled evangelization is one guided by the Holy Spirit, for he is the soul of the Church called to proclaim the Gospel...I once more invoke the Holy Spirit. I implore him to come and renew the Church, to stir and impel her to go forth boldly to evangelize all peoples.” (261)

Today, we pray for the soul of Pope Francis, we pray for the College of Cardinals which will elect his successor, and we pray for his successor who will be elevated to the Chair of Saint Peter.

As we pray for the soul of our Holy Father Pope Francis on this Easter Octave Monday, we remember his words on our Lord’s Resurrection.

In *The Joy of the Gospel*, Pope Francis writes: “Christ’s resurrection is not an event of the past; it contains a vital power which has permeated the world. Where all seems to be dead, signs of the resurrection suddenly spring up. It is an irresistible force...Each day in our world beauty is born anew, it rises transformed through the storms of history...Such is the power of the resurrection, and all who evangelize are instruments of that power.” (276)

May the Word of God be a Light and a Lamp for our steps and may the Holy Spirit lead and guide us!

Declaración del Obispo Barres sobre la muerte del Papa Francisco 21 de Abril, 2025

Mientras lloramos la muerte del Papa Francisco en este Lunes de la Octava de Pascua, y damos gracias por el don de su evangelización global contemplativa, enraizada en Mateo 25 y en las obras de misericordia espirituales y corporales, damos gracias al Padre, al Hijo y al Espíritu Santo por sus gracias y carismas únicos, y por la forma tan conmovedora en que, durante su Pontificado, ha sido una Luz de Jesucristo y de la misión de misericordia de la Iglesia Católica para el mundo.

En Evangelii Gaudium (2013), el Papa Francisco habla sobre la frescura original del Evangelio: «Jesús también puede irrumpir en las categorías aburridas con las que pretendemos encerrarlo, y constantemente nos sorprende con su creatividad divina. Cada vez que hacemos el esfuerzo de volver a la fuente y recuperar la frescura original del Evangelio, surgen nuevos caminos, se abren sendas de creatividad con diferentes formas de expresión, signos más elocuentes y palabras cargadas de un nuevo significado para el mundo actual. Toda forma de auténtica evangelización es siempre "nueva"» (n. 11).

El compromiso del Papa Francisco con la frescura del Evangelio y su deseo de forjar nuevos caminos de creatividad misionera se expresaron en sus encíclicas Lumen Fidei (2013), Laudato si' (2015), Fratelli Tutti (2020) y Dilexit Nos (2024), junto con sus exhortaciones apostólicas Evangelii Gaudium (2013), Amoris Laetitia (2016), Gaudete et Exsultate (2018), Christus Vivit (2019), Querida Amazonia (2020), Laudate Deum (2023) y C'est la confiance (2023).

Este pasaje de Evangelii Gaudium capta, a mi parecer, el amor apasionado del Papa Francisco por la Iglesia y el mundo, y seguirá inspirándonos mientras el Espíritu Santo nos conduce más profundamente en este siglo XXI:«¿Cuánto deseo encontrar las palabras adecuadas para despertar el entusiasmo por un nuevo capítulo de evangelización lleno de fervor, alegría, generosidad, valentía, amor sin límites y atracción! Pero me doy cuenta de que ningún tipo de motivación será suficiente si no arde en los corazones el fuego del Espíritu Santo. Una evangelización con espíritu es una evangelización guiada por el Espíritu Santo, ya que Él es el alma de la Iglesia evangelizadora... Una vez más invoco al Espíritu Santo. Le imploro que venga a renovar la Iglesia, a sacudirla y empujarla a salir con valentía para evangelizar a todos los pueblos.» (n. 261)

Oremos hoy por el alma del Papa Francisco, oremos por el Colegio de Cardenales que elegirá a su sucesor, y oremos por su sucesor, quien será elevado a la Cátedra de San Pedro.

Al orar por el alma de nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, en este Lunes de la Octava de Pascua, recordemos sus palabras sobre la Resurrección de nuestro Señor. En La Alegría del Evangelio, el Papa Francisco escribe:«La resurrección de Cristo no es un hecho del pasado; encierra una fuerza de vida que ha penetrado el mundo. Donde todo parece muerto, por todas partes vuelven a aparecer los brotes de la resurrección. Es una fuerza imparable... Cada día en el mundo renace la belleza, que se transforma a través de los dramas de la historia... Tal es la fuerza de la resurrección, y todo evangelizador es un instrumento de ese poder» (n. 276).

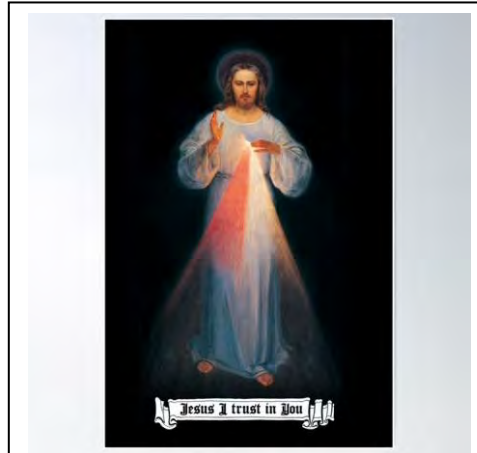
