DEACON'S CORNER



“God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life.” (See Saint John 3:16-18) On page five of *Mystery of Faith*, in the chapter dedicated to the Trinity, Fr. Michael J. Himes states: “The Trinity is not one doctrine among others: It is the whole of Christian doctrine.” This is so true! “I believe in God,” thus we start our Creed every Sunday Mass, and then we add “the Father.” That is, the very first thing we say about our God is that He is the

Father. This means that He has a Son. But the Son of God cannot be less God than the Father is, just as the son of a human is not less human than his father. The text above gives another very good reason for us to believe in the Trinity. God is love, and love cannot exist by itself. Love needs to be expressed and reciprocated. We believe the Holy Spirit to be that eternal expression of the love between the Father and the Son. May our own lives always be modeled after this Divine Pattern!

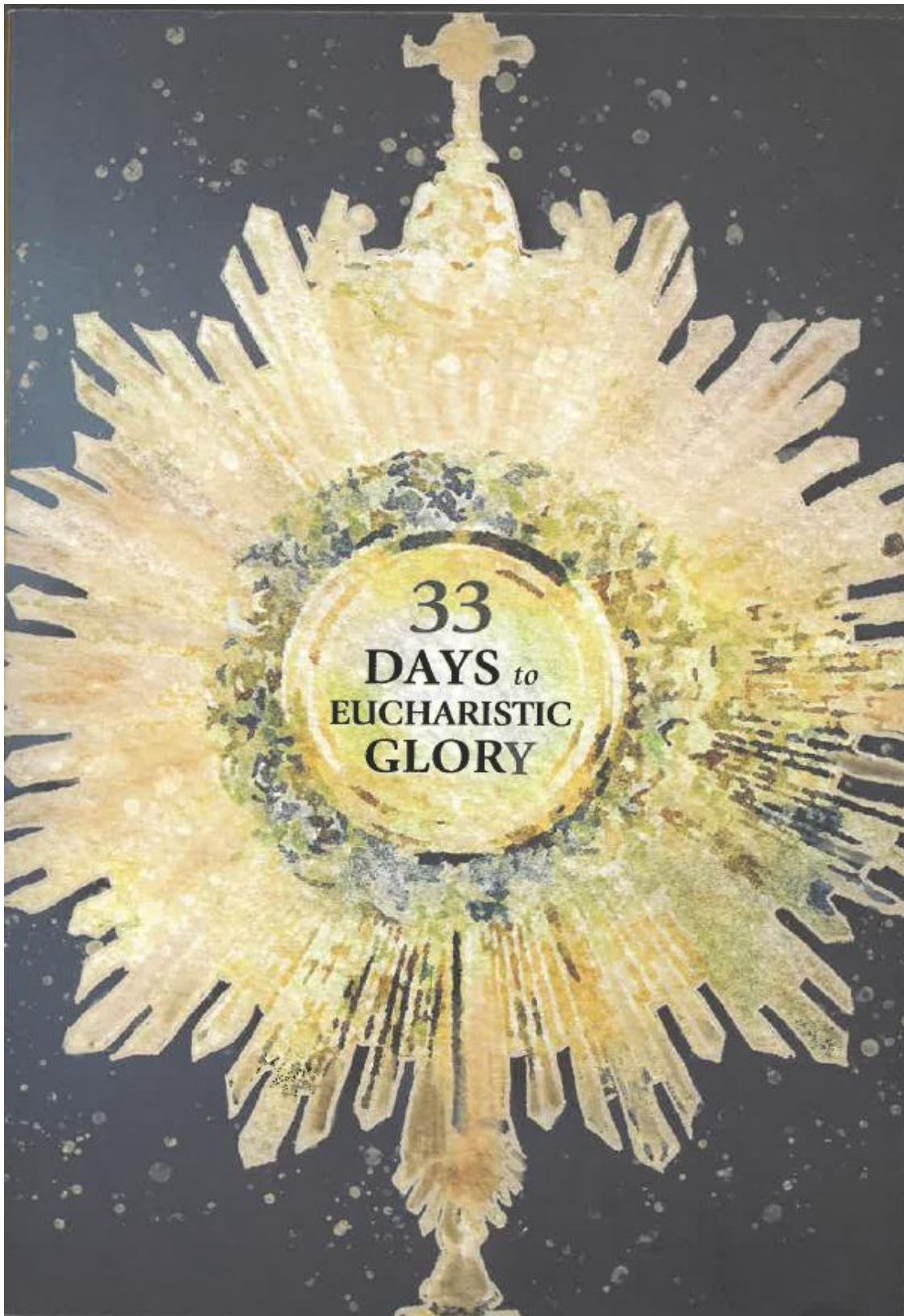

Himes declara: “La Trinidad no es una doctrina más entre tantas: Es el todo y total de la doctrina cristiana.” ¡Eso es tan cierto! “Creo en un solo Dios,” así comenzamos el Credo en todas nuestras Misas dominicales, y entonces continuamos diciendo “Padre.” Es decir, lo primero que decimos acerca de Dios es que es Padre. Eso significa que tiene un Hijo. Pero el hijo de Dios no puede ser menos Dios que el Padre mismo, tal como el hijo de un ser humano no puede ser menos ser humano que su padre. El texto de arriba nos suministra otra buena razón para creer en la Trinidad. Dios es amor. El amor no puede existir por sí solo. El amor tiene que ser expresado y reciprocado. Nosotros creemos que el Espíritu Santo es esa eterna expresión de amor entre el Padre y el Hijo. ¡Que nuestra vida de familia siempre trate de imitar el Modelo divino de amor!

Pastor's Message: The Most Holy Trinity

We are created in the image and likeness of God. This is biblical.

Therefore, the more we know and understand God, the more we know and understand humanity / ourselves.

--This is very timely today with all the racial and civil unrest that has resulted. People need to see the likeness of God in people that are different from them. Humanity has a long way to go.

God can only be God in a Trinitarian Relationship—Therefore, we can only be fully human by being a member of a family and community.— We need the community to challenge our selfishness, our ego, self-centeredness, to challenge prejudice, but also to affirm the goodness in us.

This is why we all miss the Eucharist / Certainly The Body of Christ on the altar the Eucharist and The Body of Christ the community that forms around our Lord's altar.

John Cardinal Newman once noted that the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity was unlike any of the other major feasts that we celebrate during the Church year. Today we celebrate NOT A MOMENT IN OUR SALVATION HISTORY—Today we celebrate THE VERY NATURE OF GOD!

I.--We are MONOTHEISTIC: ONE GOD... HOWEVER WE BELIEVE THAT GOD IS A TRINITY / COMMUNITY OF PERSONS..."Two is company and three is COMMUNITY"

Our faith life is very individualistic has also flowed over into our Catholic faith belief system: For Example: Its MY salvation is between me and God--I am responsible for myself and no one else. So, you may wonder why we as a Church--when we gather at mass we pay so much attention to our human experience of community. Why we place so much emphasis on our: Communal prayers at Mass, the Sign of Peace, the communion Rite of processing together to receive Holy Communion, communal Penance Services. We live in a tension between I \longleftrightarrow We.

IN OUR BELIEF SYSTEM--We made the TURN TO THE SUBJECT "I" the INDIVIDUAL BUT IN OUR WORSHIP OUR COMMUNAL PRAYER WE EMPHASIZE THE COMMUNAL—WHY IS THIS?

The answer has a great deal to do with the VERY NATURE OF GOD.

II.-- One of the most profound teachings of Jesus is that God is in Himself a community, that we are made in God's image and likeness, and that in Christ we are to become like God. God is Three Persons, a community of persons that exists in love. That is the inner nature of God, that is the life of heaven, and that is what we are called to live here on earth.

In the Book of Genesis God says. "Let us make man in OUR image..." We are called into existence, to be in and to live in a relational existence. (NOT MY IMAGE).

--We discover who we are and find meaning in life ONLY IN THE CONTEXT OF FAMILY and COMMUNITY.

--It is only when we experience the JOY and PEACE in this context is when we being TO TASTE HEAVEN AND EXPERIENCE THE ULTIMATE COMMUNITY OF GOD... the communion of THREE in ONE.

**When you live in communion with others you become more than just yourself.

By being a member of a community, we are expanded, broadened, and deepened.**

--The belief in the Holy Trinity is based upon Christ's life and is found in his constant references to His Father in Heaven and to the Holy Spirit.

III.-- What does the Dogma of the Holy Trinity mean for you and me in our everyday living? Well, it means that our lives are geared to be relational, to live in Community.

We grow and discover who we are by being an active member of a worshipping community. When we become more like God in the way we live with others, then God's presence, power, and love are made all that much more real for those who live around us.

--The more we care and are concerned with those around us the more we become filled with God's holiness, not only for our own sake but for the sake of others who know us and love us.--Loving others as Christ loves them is essential; it is of the essence of being one with Christ.

It is the only way we can understand what St. John is talking about when he says that God is love and he who loves has found God, and God lives in him.

--The doctrine of the Trinity rests upon the great Commandment: Love one another as I have loved you. That we have AGAPE love towards all of humanity. Agape love (not filial love or eros love) is a glimpse of divine love (as I have loved you).

--Jesus told us that heaven begins here on earth. The kingdom of heaven is here, among you, He told us. We are not far from it. The life of God begins to be experienced here. Heaven is not a prize dangled in front of us. Heaven isn't the reward at the end of a road of pain, trial, and suffering. Heaven and our Salvation begin in this life, when we begin to live a Trinitarian/Communal life with others, building the Kingdom of God. Living and putting into practice all that our Lord taught, stood for and died for.

The Importance of the Doctrine of the Holy Trinity lies in this: we are made in God's image--therefore, the more we understand about God, the more we understand about ourselves. Scholars say that people tend to take on the qualities or become more like the god they worship (e.g. War mongering, wrath, loving). What does the doctrine of the Blessed Trinity tell us about the kind of God we worship and the kind of people we want to be?

We are made in God's image and Likeness... God can only be God in a Trinitarian relationship...so we can only be fully human by being a member of a community. The Doctrine of the Trinity challenges us to live in a: I - God - Neighbor principle. I am a Catholic in that I live in relationship with God and others. This challenges our self-centeredness and our prejudices.

CONCLUSION: We believe in a Triune God of whom we are created in his likeness. All human beings are created in his likeness. We have to look for that likeness in others. Until we find it there will always be racial hatred. The more we understand about God, the more we understand about ourselves.
