DEACON'S CORNER



“Take courage, it is I; *do not be afraid.*” (See Saint Matthew 14:22-33) The disciples were terrified. It was evening and their boat was a few miles offshore and they were being tossed about by the waves, “for the wind was against it.” Then they see one of Jesus’ most awesome miracles, the Lord comes to them “walking on the sea”! We witness here an echo of Psalm 77:19 where the Psalmist referring to God says: “Your path led through the sea, your way through the mighty waters, though your footprints were not seen.” How reassuring is this passage whenever we are in the midst of an

unsurmountable problem with seemingly no way out—be it a personal tragedy or a worldwide pandemic. It may be dark. It may seem as if we are going to perish, but it is then that the Lord comes to us to help us out of the situation and tell us to take courage and not be afraid. Let us do Him homage as the disciples did: “truly you are the Son of God”!

Vamos a rendirle homenaje como lo hicieron los discípulos: "¡Verdaderamente Tú eres el Hijo de Dios"!

Homily Nineteenth Sunday OT A 2026 Keep Focused on Jesus: And Be Not Afraid.

I-- Businesses and Corporations these days have their employees do a Time-Analysis Survey where each employee monitors every 15 min what they are doing or working on. They do this for the whole day for several days. The results are analyzed so the productivity of the employee can be maximized. The purpose is to cut out wasted time to increase profits.

If each of us did a Time-Analysis Survey during our waking hours (6am to 10pm) and wrote down what we are thinking of every 15min and that were analyzed. I bet that most people are thinking about their problems or their children's problems and/ or daydreaming about them. People are worrying and focused on the storms in their life.

First, we have to say that this miracle of Jesus walking on water did take place as told in the Gospel. I hate it when writers and theologians try to "water down" the Gospel and try to explain away what really took place.

The Gospel message clearly tells us today: that we need to stay focused on Jesus always and not our problems/ not the storms in one's life. As soon as we take our attention off him and begin to focus on our problems: we begin to sink and drown. Message is: stay focused on Jesus and not our problems and difficulties.

It is a matter of Trust: we think by worrying about the storms in our life, worrying about our problems, ruminating over them: it will somehow help

This miracle of walking on water did take place but we can't get caught up in that. There is so much more symbolism and meaning for us in this miracle.

The storm represents: the storms in our lives: all of our sufferings, trials, illnesses and difficulties in life. Being tossed about like a small boat.

Jesus coming across the water, symbolizes how he Himself transcends and can overcome all of this world's concerns and problems, he rises above all the difficulties in life.

--MESSAGE: whatever storms we find ourselves in any trial or difficulty: WE NEED TO STAY FOCUSED ON JESUS (PUT GOD FIRST). NOT our DIFFICULTIES / THE PROBLEMS: HE WILL GET US THROUGH THE STORM.

STAY FOCUSED: if we could stay focused on Jesus, that is be thinking about him, every waking moment of our lives(Time Analysis Survey) and not our problems, difficulties and storms, we would draw closer to Him, and he will get us through any storm life can through at you.

--one way to stay focused on Jesus is by repeating a mantra under our breath as we go through the day: like the Jesus prayer: **Lord Jesus Christ have mercy on me a sinner.** With every inhale of breath in a very low voice say, "Lord Jesus Christ" and with the exhale say, "have mercy on me a sinner". If this prayer becomes part of your breathing and part of your consciousness, you will be focused on the Lord and not the problems and difficulties in your life.

-- another way is to have a sense of gratitude and repeat: **thank you Lord, thank you Lord** over and over again.

--remember the people who have nothing in their lives but still have God; are the richest people in the world.

The idea: is to repeat something and every waking moment to stay focused on Jesus and he will get us through any storm in life.

This is not being passive in the face of problems: is taking the posture: **Lord my life is in your hands**. Because it really is. This may sound naive or too simplistic, but our Lord invites you to have the faith of Peter and take that first step and try it. Spend every conscious waking moment focused on him...and see how he will get you through any storm life can throw at you. It is not going to make your life easy, but you will see how our Lord will get you through any storm in life.

Jesus walked on water to show to us he has dominion over the world order and to show us he can rise above and overcome any problem and difficulty in life.

CONCLUSION: let us recall the first words that John Paul II enunciated in October 1978, when he became our Pope. What did he say? He simply exclaimed, "**Be not Afraid!**" And for nearly the next three decades, he would remind us of the words spoken to Peter by Jesus - words that have significance for us in our own time.





LORD, SAVE ME!

After He had fed the people, Jesus made the disciples get into a boat and precede Him to the other side, while He dismissed the crowds. After doing so, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. ... Meanwhile the boat, already a few miles offshore, was being tossed about by the waves, for the wind was against it. During the fourth watch of the night, He came toward them walking on the sea. When the disciples saw Him walking on the sea they were terrified. "It is a ghost," they said, and they cried out in fear. At once Jesus spoke to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter said to Him in reply, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." He said, "Come." Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw how strong the wind was he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" After they got into the boat, the wind died down. Those who were in the boat did Him homage, saying, "Truly, You are the Son of God."

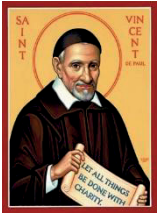
